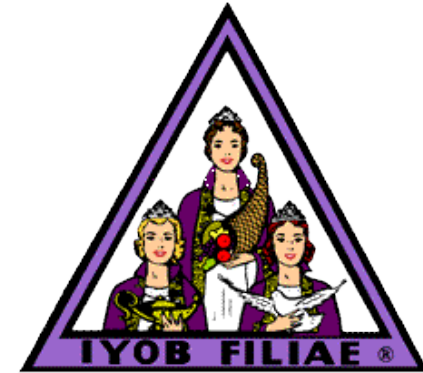
The Taste of Morgan Hill was a fun event! We met several families and we are now inviting you to a couple of activities!
